

Dear Members

Brilliant sunshine greeted those in attendance at Remembrance Day services in Kyneton and Trentham this year and numerous wreaths were laid in memory of the fallen. We were pleased to have Federal Member for Bendigo, Lisa Chesters, and State Member for Macedon, Mary-Anne Thomas, attend the ceremony in Kyneton and lay wreaths on behalf of their constituents. Our last remaining Korean veteran, former President of the Kyneton RSL and Life Member, John Munro, also travelled down from Moama to lay a wreath on behalf of Korean veterans. Students from local schools in Kyneton, Trentham and Tylden also played a significant part in both ceremonies and it is always a pleasure to have them participate. A big thank you also to Craig Byrne who ran the ceremony in Kyneton, as I was occupied in Trentham.

We also conducted ceremonies for the residents in Respect RM Begg, BUPA and Trentham Aged Care facilities. Many of these residents are unable to attend the ceremonies on Remembrance Day and are always appreciative of the services we conduct on their behalf.

The Poppy Appeal, whilst a little down on previous years, raised close to \$7000 and we are very much appreciative of all those who bought poppies or simply made a donation in support of our

We conducted ceremonies to commemorate Victory in the Pacific Day on 15 August and Vietnam Veterans Day on 18 August. Following the VP Day ceremony, we were pleased to host several of our World War II veterans to lunch at the RSL. Sadly, our oldest WWII veteran, Joyce Strawhorn, who reached her 103rd birthday on 18 September, passed away on 15 October. Joyce served in both the WAAAF and AWAS during WWII. Russ McGregor delivered a poignant insight into his time in Vietnam at the Vietnam Veterans' Day ceremony.

On 31 October we conducted a small wreathlaying ceremony at the Light Horse Monument in Jennings Street to commemorate Beersheba Day. Several members of the Light Horse Association travelled up from Melbourne to join us in the ceremony. The main role of the Kyneton RSL, which is to provide assistance to our veterans, continues unabated. Details of the support we provide can found on Page 7. As well as assisting our own veterans we have provided assistance to other RSLs in the region. Following a recent request from the Woodend RSL, we donated \$5000 to them to assist with the replacement and installation of a new dishwasher to enable them to get their kitchen back up and running.

As well as supporting our veterans we also provide support to many local sporting clubs, community organisations, schools and festivals. Details of this support can be found on Page 3.

The State Annual Conference of the RSL was held in July. We had four delegates attend online at the Bendigo RSL, an arrangement that proved quite successful as well as convenient. One significant change that came out of the conference was to provide free membership of the RSL for serving members of the ADF. If you are a member of the Kyneton RSL and are still serving, please let us know so that your membership fee can be waived. We would also like to reiterate that the membership fee for Service members over 80 is also waived. This is also a timely reminder that membership renewals are now due. Please ensure that you renew your membership before 31 January as all RSL Rewards points expire at that time and your membership will go into Lapsed status and all benefits will be suspended. Remember that Rewards points can be used to renew your membership. I would also like to mention that new membership cards are now available at the RSL. These will be issued when you renew your membership. If you are not due for renewal, you can call into the RSL and the staff will issue your new card.

This year we have again submitted a nomination in the annual Hall of Fame Awards for Sub-Branch of the Year. We believe we have made a strong case for the Kyneton RSL but the outcome won't be known until the New Year. Our submission is based on our strong record of excellent service to our members and guests and support to our veterans and the wider community. It is also a reflection of the great work put in by all committee members and staff at the Kyneton RSL.

On 3 December, we hosted Veterans, their partners and Legacy Widows to our annual combined Christmas Lunch. Over 90 people were in attendance and were treated to a traditional Christmas lunch and all received a little bag of Christmas cheer. Warren's alter ego, Santa Claus, contributed to the festive spirit. All reports indicated that the day was enjoyed by evervone.




Support to the Community




